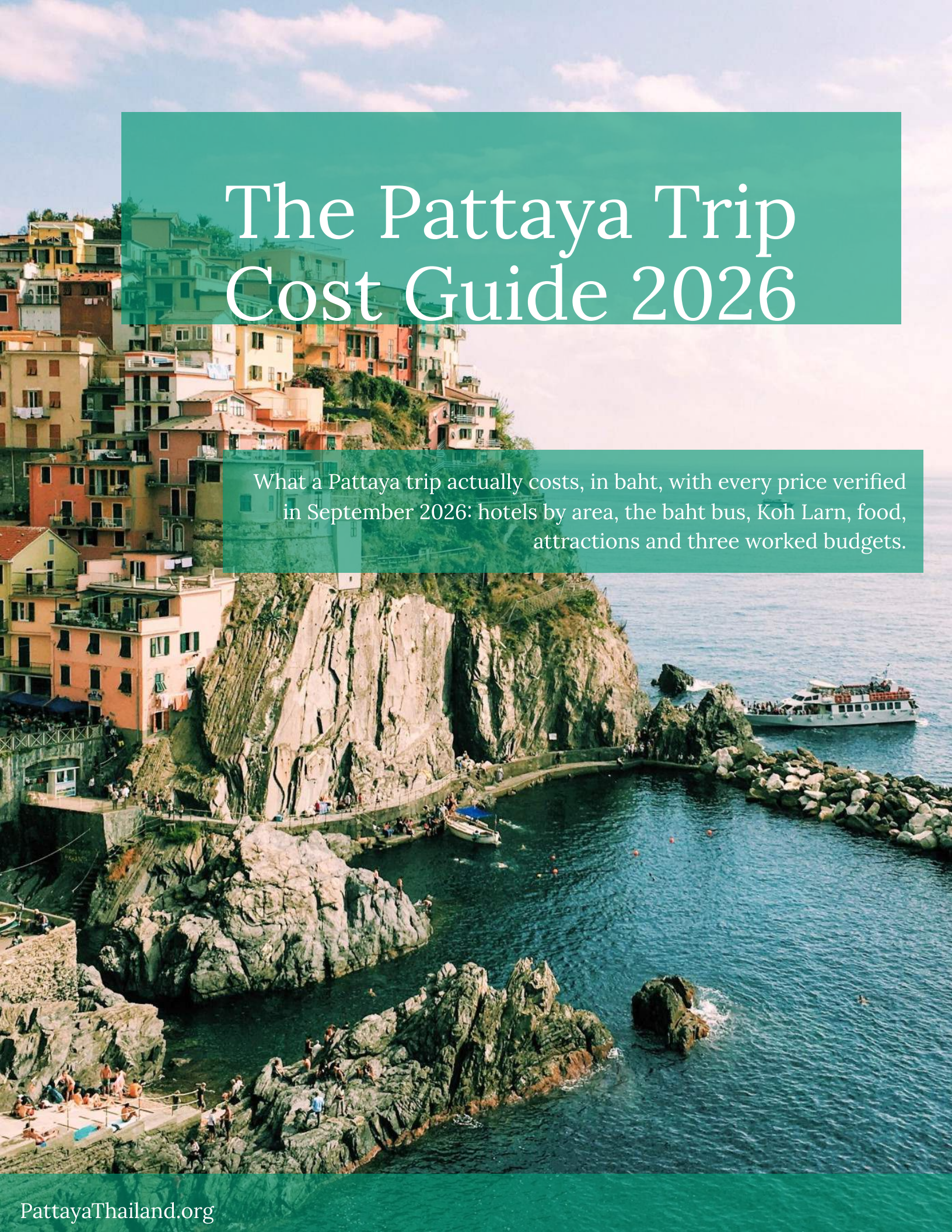

What a Pattaya trip actually costs, in baht, with every price checked against the source it came from. Room rates for 130 hotels by area, the new baht-bus fare, the Koh Larn ferry, entry prices, food, and three worked budgets you can copy.

Prices verified September 2026

Fares and entry prices change. The live version of every number in this guide is kept at pattayathailand.org/guide-updates.

Before you start

This guide exists because the question we get asked most is not "what should I see in Pattaya" but "what is this going to cost me". Every figure here is either a posted price we checked in person or online in September 2026, or a rate pulled from a live booking search for December stay dates. Where a price is a range, the range is what people actually pay, not the number a tout quotes.

Three things to know about the numbers. First, hotel rates are **before tax**: most Pattaya hotels add 7% VAT and a 10% service charge at checkout, so add roughly 17% to any room rate you see here. Second, everything is in Thai baht. The baht has traded between roughly ฿32 and ฿36 to the US dollar over the past two years; divide by 33 for a quick estimate and check a live rate before you fly. Third, the cheapest option is not always listed first. Where the cheapest option is also the one that goes wrong most often, we say so.

Prices go stale. The baht-bus fare in this guide changed in April 2026 after fifteen years at ฿10. When something else moves, the correction goes on [the updates page](#) first. If you downloaded this more than six months ago, check there before you budget.

Disclosure. Some links in this guide go to Klook, a booking site. If you book through them, PattayaThailand.org earns a small commission and you pay the same price. We only link tours and tickets we would book ourselves, and we tell you when the walk-up price is better.

If you would rather have the numbers as a calculator, the [Pattaya trip cost planner](#) on the site does the arithmetic for your dates, group size and style, and shows the rooms that fit your ceiling.

The short answer

For two people sharing a room, four nights, doing the things most first visits do (a Koh Larn day, the Sanctuary of Truth, an evening on Walking Street), here is what the trip costs on the ground, not counting flights.

Backpack — room ceiling: ฿1,000 · food per person per day: ฿320 · four nights for two: ฿8,200 · per person per day: about ฿1,030

Standard — room ceiling: ฿2,400 · food per person per day: ฿700 · four nights for two: ฿16,300 · per person per day: about ฿2,040

Comfort — room ceiling: ฿6,000 · food per person per day: ฿1,500 · four nights for two: ฿33,000 · per person per day: about ฿4,120

The full working for each of those, line by line, is in the sample budgets chapter near the end. The rest of this guide is what goes into them: where the money goes and where it does not need to.

Two rules of thumb hold across all three styles. Accommodation is the only cost that varies by more than a factor of two between areas, so choosing the area is the biggest budgeting decision you will make. And transport is close to free if you use the baht bus and expensive if you use anything else; a couple taking Grab everywhere spends more on rides in four days than a backpacker spends on food.

Getting to Pattaya

From Suvarnabhumi airport

Pattaya is about 150 km southeast of Bangkok, and the airport is on the right side of the city, so you do not need to go into Bangkok at all.

Airport bus (Roong Reuang) — fare: ฿162 per person · time: about 2 hours · notes: departures spread through the day, roughly every two hours; drops at Jomtien bus station, not the centre

Shared van, booked online — fare: from about ฿300 per person · time: 2 to 2.5 hours · notes: hotel drop-off in Pattaya; book ahead

Metered taxi from the rank — fare: ฿1,399 to ฿1,699 · time: 1.5 to 2.5 hours · notes: fixed transfer including tolls; use the official rank on level 1, not anyone who approaches you

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Grab — fare: ฿1,200 to ฿1,500 · time: 1.5 to 2.5 hours · notes: order from the app pickup zone; price includes tolls

For a group of three or four the taxi and the airport bus cost about the same per person, and the taxi takes you to the door. Solo travellers on a budget should take the bus and then a baht bus or Grab from Jomtien station. If you want the door-to-door option without the taxi rank, the [Bangkok to Pattaya shared van on Klook](#) books to a fixed time and picks up at the airport.

From Bangkok city

Roong Reuang coaches run from Ekkamai (Eastern) bus terminal for ฿148 and from Mo Chit for ฿158, taking two to two and a half hours and arriving at the Pattaya bus terminal on North Pattaya Road. There is also a train: the daily third-class service is ฿30 and takes close to four hours, and the weekend air-conditioned express (train 998) is ฿170 in about two and a half hours. The train is a nice ride, not a fast one.

Entry rules that changed this month

Visa-free stay is now 30 days, not 60. From 15 September 2026 Thailand cut the visa exemption for most nationalities, including the US, UK, EU and Australia, from 60 days to 30. A one-time 30-day extension is available at the immigration office for about ฿1,900. Older blog posts and guidebooks still say 60. Every arrival also needs the free Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC), completed online within 72 hours before you land; you will be asked for the QR code.

Where to stay, and what each area costs

These rates come from a search of 130 Pattaya properties for December stay dates, the start of high season, taken in September 2026. They are the nightly rate before tax and fees. Low season (May to October) typically runs 20 to 40% cheaper, and the week between Christmas and New Year runs higher. For each area: how far it is from the centre, how many rooms were in the sample, and the cheapest, median and priciest nightly rate.

How to read that list

South Pattaya and Jomtien are where the genuine sub-฿1,000 rooms are. Jomtien has the beach and a slower pace; South Pattaya has Walking Street and the pier within walking distance. [Our Jomtien guide](#) covers the trade-off in detail.

Central Pattaya has the most stock and the most choice at every price, which is why its median sits in the middle. It is the safe default if you have not been before.

Pratumnak Hill is the quiet, slightly upmarket hill between Pattaya and Jomtien. Good value for what you get, but you will use the baht bus or Grab to go anywhere.

Beach Road, North Pattaya and Naklua are where the big resorts are. The medians are pulled up by four- and five-star properties; there are cheap rooms in each, just fewer of them. [Naklua](#) is the calmest beachfront in town.

Bang Saray and Na Jomtien are a different holiday: quiet beaches 10 to 17 km south, resort prices, and you will want a car or a scooter.

Rooms that scored well without costing much

From the same search: properties with a guest score of 8.5 or better from at least 300 reviews, cheapest first. Scores are the booking site's ten-point guest rating.

Rates move daily, so treat these as a starting shortlist rather than a quote. The [hotel price guide](#) and the [cheap hotels page](#) on the site are updated more often than this PDF, and the [trip planner](#) filters the full list by your budget.

Getting around

The baht bus (songthaew)

The blue pick-up trucks with two benches in the back are Pattaya's public transport. They run fixed loops: down Beach Road, back up Second Road, and out to Jomtien and Naklua. You flag one, get in the back, press the buzzer when you want off, and pay the driver through the window.

The fare is ฿15, or ฿20 on the longer Jomtien and Naklua runs. It went up from ฿10 on 10 April 2026, the first increase in years. Anything you read that says ฿10 is out of date; anyone who asks you for ฿50 for a ride down Beach Road is not.

The one rule that saves you money: do not ask the driver anything before you get in. The moment you ask "how much to X" or name a destination, the driver can treat the ride as a private charter and quote ฿100 to ฿200 or more. If the truck is going your way, get in and pay ฿15 when you get out. If you actually want a charter (say, five of you to Nong Nooch), agree the price first and it is often cheaper than two Grabs.

Grab, Bolt and motorbike taxis

Grab works well in Pattaya. Expect ฿80 to ฿150 for a ride within town and ฿150 to ฿250 for longer runs such as Central Pattaya to Na Jomtien. Bolt is usually a little cheaper on the same route. Motorbike taxis, the drivers in numbered vests at street corners, are ฿40 to ฿100 depending on distance and are the fastest way through Second Road traffic at 6 pm; agree the price before you get on.

Renting a scooter

Automatic scooters rent for about ฿200 to ฿300 a day, less by the week. Three cautions. Your travel insurance almost certainly does not cover you without a motorcycle licence and an International Driving Permit. Police checkpoints on Second Road and the Sukhumvit fine riders without a helmet or licence, typically ฿500 to ฿1,000. And photograph the bike, every panel, before you ride away; damage disputes on return are the most common complaint we hear.

Walking

The centre is more walkable than it looks. Bali Hai Pier to the Walking Street arch is 905 metres, about ten minutes. Beach Road end to end is just under three kilometres. Jomtien is not walkable from the centre in the heat; take the ฿20 baht bus. [Our Walking Street guide](#) has the routes and what is where.

Koh Larn: the day trip everyone takes

Koh Larn is the island 7 km off Pattaya with the beaches that Pattaya Beach is not. Almost everyone goes, and almost everyone overpays for the same day the first time. The full breakdown is in our [Koh Larn cost guide](#) and [ferry guide](#); here is the money version.

Public ferry, each way — price: ฿30 · notes: from Bali Hai Pier to Na Baan or Tawaen pier, 40 to 45 minutes; buy at the pier window, not from anyone outside it

Speedboat charter — price: ฿1,500 to ฿3,500 · notes: whole boat, 15 minutes; worth it for a group of six, a trap for a couple

Island songthaew, pier to beach — price: ฿40 to ฿70 per person · notes: motorbike taxis charge about the same

Motorbike rental on the island — price: about ฿300 a day · notes: same licence and helmet rules as the mainland

Beach lounge — price: ฿100 · notes: for the day, usually with an umbrella

Lunch on the beach — price: ฿150 to ฿300 per person · notes: slightly above mainland prices; the seafood is the point

Snorkel gear or a banana boat — price: ฿100 to ฿400 · notes: negotiable; more at Tawaen than at Samae or Tien

The last public ferry back leaves around 17:30. Miss it and you are paying for a speedboat charter or a room on the island. Leave your beach by 16:45; the island songthaew does not hurry.

A do-it-yourself Koh Larn day therefore costs about ฿500 to ฿800 per person including the ferry, transport on the island, a lounge and lunch. It is the cheapest good day out in Pattaya.

The organised alternative is a [Koh Larn and Koh Sak speedboat day trip](#), which bundles hotel pickup, the boat both ways, snorkelling and lunch, or the cheaper [half-day Koh Larn tour](#) that covers just the crossing and a few hours on the beach. They cost more than doing it yourself and less than a private speedboat, and they solve the last-ferry problem for you. If you want to combine the island with the Sanctuary of Truth in one long day, the [Sanctuary of Truth and Koh Larn join-in tour](#) does both.

Food and drink

Pattaya is cheap to eat in if you eat Thai, and no cheaper than home if you eat Western. These are posted prices from the places we actually use.

Som tam (papaya salad) — price: ฿70 to ฿100 · where: street stalls, market food courts

Pad thai, fried rice, noodle soup — price: ฿80 to ฿120 · where: street and shophouse restaurants

Grilled whole seabass — price: ฿250 to ฿350 · where: seafood restaurants on Jomtien and Naklua

Clams, stir-fried — price: ฿120 to ฿180 · where: same

Beer, large bottle — price: ฿70 to ฿100 · where: street bars and beer bars; supermarkets are roughly half

Cocktail — price: ฿150 to ฿300 · where: beach bars and rooftop bars

Coffee — price: ฿60 to ฿120 · where: cafés; ฿40 at 7-Eleven

Bottled water, 600 ml — price: ฿10 to ฿20 · where: everywhere; ฿50 at attractions

Western breakfast — price: ฿150 to ฿300 · where: hotel or café

Pizza or a burger — price: ฿250 to ฿450 · where: Central Pattaya and Beach Road

Three daily food baskets

Backpack, ฿320 a day: som tam or noodle soup for breakfast at a market, pad thai at lunch, a plate of fried rice and one beer at dinner. You will not go hungry.

Standard, ฿700 a day: a market or café breakfast, a sit-down lunch, and a grilled seabass at a seafood place for dinner with a couple of drinks.

Comfort, ฿1,500 a day: hotel breakfast, a beach-club lunch on Jomtien, and a full seafood dinner with clams, prawns and wine or cocktails.

The single biggest food saving is where you eat breakfast. Hotel breakfasts in Pattaya are often ฿250 to ฿400 when not included in the rate; the market two streets away will feed you for ฿60.

Attractions and what they cost

Posted prices at the gate, checked September 2026. Where booking online is cheaper or avoids a queue, we say so.

Sanctuary of Truth — entry: ฿500 · hours: 08:00 to 18:00 · notes: the all-teak carved temple in Naklua; the one thing in Pattaya nobody calls a tourist trap; go before 9 am

Nong Nooch Tropical Garden — entry: ฿280 garden, ฿560 with shows · hours: daytime · notes: 20 km south; budget half a day plus transport

Big Buddha, Wat Phra Yai — entry: free · hours: daylight · notes: short climb from Pratumnak; best just before sunset

Pattaya Floating Market — entry: ฿200 · hours: daytime · notes: more if you eat your way along the boardwalk, which is the point

Koh Larn — entry: ฿30 ferry each way · hours: last boat about 17:30 · notes: cheapest good day out; see the previous chapter

Jet ski, 30 minutes — entry: ฿700 to ฿1,000 · hours: beach hours · notes: photograph existing scratches before you ride; damage claims are the classic Pattaya scam

Parasailing — entry: ฿300 to ฿800 · hours: beach hours · notes: price depends on the beach and your haggling

Cabaret shows (Tiffany's, Alcazar) — entry: varies by seat · hours: evening · notes: online tickets are cheaper than the door and let you pick the seat block

The three attractions worth booking before you arrive are the [Sanctuary of Truth ticket](#), [Nong Nooch Tropical Garden](#) and a [Koh Larn speedboat day trip](#); all three sell on Klook with mobile tickets, so you show your phone at the gate. For the shows, [Tiffany's Show](#) and the [Alcazar Cabaret](#) are both a short baht-bus ride up Second Road. Our [things to do guide](#) has the full list, including the free ones.

Nightlife on a budget

Walking Street is free to walk, and a lot of people spend nothing there beyond a beer. A large bottle at a street bar is ฿70 to ฿100; the same bottle inside a club is ฿150 to ฿250, and some clubs charge an entry fee that includes a drink. Buying drinks for staff, the "lady drink", is ฿150 to ฿300 each and is how bars make money; it is optional, and the friendliest way to decline is to say you are just having one. Bar bills in Pattaya are paid at the end from a cup on your table; check it before you pay. [Our Walking Street guide](#) covers the rest.

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A realistic evening out, three or four drinks and a late snack, is ฿600 per person at street-bar prices and ฿1,500 or more if you are in clubs. Soi Buakhao and the beer bars off Second Road are the cheaper version of the same night.

Three worked budgets

Two people sharing one room, four nights, arriving on the airport bus and leaving the same way. Rooms use the December median for the area named; food uses the baskets above; transport assumes four baht-bus rides a day each, or two Grabs a day for the comfort budget. Airport transfers are listed separately because they vary most.

Backpack: ฿8,200 for two, about ฿1,030 per person per day

Room, South Pattaya or Jomtien guesthouse — $4 \text{ nights} \times \text{฿}900 = \text{฿}3,600$

Food — $4 \text{ days} \times 2 \text{ people} \times \text{฿}320 = \text{฿}2,560$

Baht bus — $4 \text{ days} \times 4 \text{ rides} \times 2 \text{ people} \times \text{฿}15 = \text{฿}480$

Koh Larn, do it yourself — $2 \times \text{฿}200 \text{ (ferry, island songthaew, lounge)} = \text{฿}400$

Big Buddha — free = ฿0

A night on Walking Street — $2 \times \text{฿}600 = \text{฿}1,200$

Total on the ground — ฿8,240

Plus airport bus both ways — $2 \text{ people} \times 2 \times \text{฿}162 = \text{฿}648$

Standard: ฿16,300 for two, about ฿2,040 per person per day

Room, Jomtien Beach median — $4 \text{ nights} \times \text{฿}1,914 = \text{฿}7,656$

Food — $4 \text{ days} \times 2 \text{ people} \times \text{฿}700 = \text{฿}5,600$

Baht bus — $4 \text{ days} \times 4 \text{ rides} \times 2 \text{ people} \times \text{฿}15 = \text{฿}480$

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Koh Larn, do it yourself — $2 \times \text{฿}200 = \text{฿}400$

Sanctuary of Truth — $2 \times \text{฿}500 = \text{฿}1,000$

A night on Walking Street — $2 \times \text{฿}600 = \text{฿}1,200$

Total on the ground — $\text{฿}16,336$

Plus airport taxi both ways — $2 \times \text{about } \text{฿}1,500 = \text{฿}3,000$

Comfort: $\text{฿}33,000$ for two, about $\text{฿}4,120$ per person per day

Room, Pattaya Beach Road median — $4 \text{ nights} \times \text{฿}3,660 = \text{฿}14,640$

Food — $4 \text{ days} \times 2 \text{ people} \times \text{฿}1,500 = \text{฿}12,000$

Grab, two trips a day — $4 \text{ days} \times 2 \times \text{฿}115 = \text{฿}920$

Koh Larn, do it yourself — $2 \times \text{฿}200 = \text{฿}400$

Sanctuary of Truth — $2 \times \text{฿}500 = \text{฿}1,000$

Nong Nooch with shows — $2 \times \text{฿}560 = \text{฿}1,120$

Jet ski or parasailing — $2 \times \text{฿}850 = \text{฿}1,700$

A night on Walking Street — $2 \times \text{฿}600 = \text{฿}1,200$

Total on the ground — $\text{฿}32,980$

Plus airport taxi both ways — $2 \times \text{about } \text{฿}1,500 = \text{฿}3,000$

Add about 17% to the room lines for VAT and service charge if your booking shows rates before tax. And remember the room line is the one you control: swap the Beach Road median for a well-rated $\text{฿}1,500$ room in Jomtien and the comfort budget drops by $\text{฿}8,600$ without changing anything you do all day. The [trip planner](#) lets you make exactly that swap and see the total move.

Where first-timers overspend

- **The baht-bus charter.** Asking the driver "how much to Jomtien" turns a ฿20 ride into a ฿150 one. Get in, sit down, pay when you get out.
- **Airport touts.** Anyone who approaches you in the arrivals hall offering a "taxi to Pattaya" will charge two to three times the rank price. Walk to the official taxi rank or the bus counter.
- **ATM fees.** Thai ATMs charge foreign cards a fee of about ฿220 per withdrawal on top of whatever your bank charges, so take out larger amounts less often, and decline the machine's offer to convert to your home currency (its rate is worse). Exchange booths in town give better rates than the airport.
- **Jet-ski damage claims.** Photograph the machine from every side, including underneath the hull, before you ride, with the operator in the shot. It is the one Pattaya scam that still catches careful people.
- **Hotel breakfast.** If it is not included, ฿250 to ฿400 a head. The market is ฿60.
- **Attraction water.** ฿50 for a bottle that is ฿10 at 7-Eleven. Carry one.
- **The wrong area.** Booking in North Pattaya for the beach and then spending every evening in South Pattaya means two rides a night. Decide where you will actually spend your evenings, then book near it.
- **Speedboats for two.** A ฿2,500 charter to Koh Larn for a couple is ฿1,250 each for a crossing the ferry does for ฿30.

Before you fly: the money checklist

- Complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card online within 72 hours of landing and save the QR code to your phone.
- Check the current visa-free allowance for your passport (30 days for most nationalities since 15 September 2026).
- Book the first night somewhere central; you can move once you know which end of town you like.
- Install Grab and Bolt before you land; both need a working phone number to register.
- Bring one card with no foreign-transaction fee and enough cash for the first day, or plan one large ATM withdrawal at the airport.
- Save the baht-bus fare in your head: ฿15, or ฿20 to Jomtien. Have coins ready.
- Screenshot this guide's attraction prices; phone signal at Bali Hai Pier is fine, but you will not want to look things up in the sun.
- Bookmark [the updates page](#) for anything that has changed since this edition.
